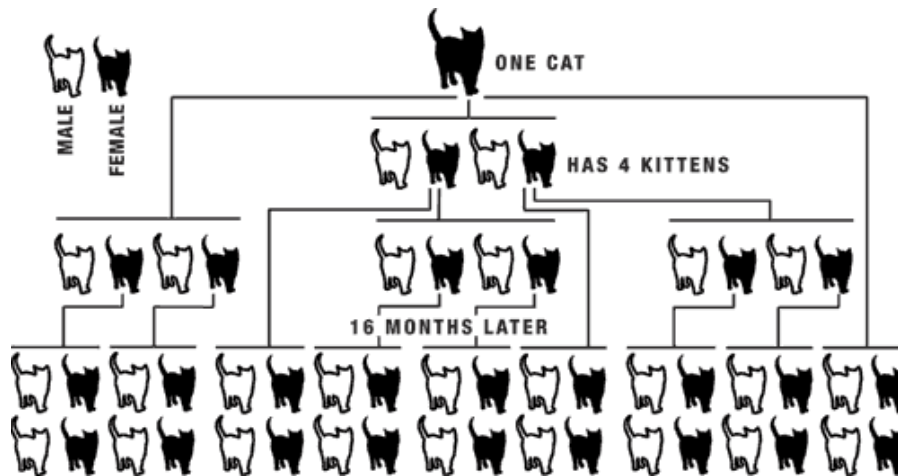

Feral cat appointments and plans must be discussed with Dr. Mark prior to the cat being brought into the facility. Feral cats will have their ear tipped to ensure the community knows they have already been fixed and vaccinated.

Feral cats **MUST** be brought in live humane traps, not in crates or carriers. This is for the safety of the staff, as well as the cat. Only **ONE** cat per trap. There are **NO** exceptions to this rule.
